Size

Approximately 8 city blocks make up Highland Park Historic District. There are 17 acres in the historic district, which is about .027 square miles.

Population

According to the 2000 Census, there are 47 households or 95 people in the area.

Natural Features

Highland Park is found atop the highlands of the area. It is located just above the bluff area of the Villa de Chantal and the Hauberg Estate. The land and the streets and yards are filled with trees, bushes and shrubs. Highland Park also features the best preserved brick streets in Rock Island.

Housing and Architecture

All of the architectural revivals, many of which were professionally designed, are present in this exclusive neighborhood in their highest form, including Colonial, Georgian, Dutch, Tudor, and Spanish. This neighborhood is a locally designated historic district, through which the Rock Island Preservation Ordinance protects the significant exterior architecture.
