The Southwest Rock Island area is not laid out in typical city blocks. It is the growth area of Rock Island and encompasses industrial land, farmland, and housing. It covers 3,623 acres or about 5.66 square miles.

Natural Features

Southwest Rock Island is found to the south of the Rock River. Most of the land is characteristic of low rolling hills and flood plains of the Rock River. Much of the land is used for agricultural purposes, however there is new development amidst the picturesque countryside.
